In the Bible, (Acts 6:2-4) God had it written, “choose seven men ... we will turn this responsibility over to them.” So, that’s what SAEM is doing; all glory to God. I don’t know if you would be surprised at the work “after hours” and on week-ends which it takes to keep SAEM operational. Let us tell you now, that the stated mission of this organization is being done night and day. It comes natural to us to be on the ball with supplying Christian literature and Benevolence to the many folks who need it and want it. God provides, when we get low on Bibles; the money is there to buy them. Therefore, “Bibles and Bread” and “Bibles and Blankets” are “catch phrases” that have become famous as we share them with Spanish readers and speakers.

We have been receiving at least 400 packages of bread products each week. Ministries from Juarez who come to pick it up take at least 50 packages each. We make sure everyone who has signed up to receive this blessing, receive their share of this bread. We are seeing more and more of the spiritual and physical blessings being shared as we recognize this is what Jesus and the disciples did. For example, these first deacons in Jerusalem.... have you thought of this? Seeing the need of the Grecian widows, the apostles decided to name the first deacons. We would like to be such “deacons”; literally “servants”. Because of the prayer Jesus taught: “give us this day our daily bread,” we love being involved. That will never be taken away from us.

Furthermore, we would like to tell you that we get feedback information from the recipients of the bread. The leaders of the children’s homes in Juarez reply to us with a great depth of gratitude, mentioning how much they appreciate the nutritional value of the types of bread received. They know that the whole wheat, the iron enriched and the rye breads are very healthy and the kids are thriving on it. The children love it, too!

**Acts of Love.** The little girl's name is Cristian Aide and her mother is Claudia. We came to know them through our friend Daniel Torres. He is the missionary in Juarez, Chih., Mexico who has been assisting our mission in bringing different forms of aid to the many families in Juarez. Daniel came to us asking for the use of our mission van to be able to transport Cristian and her mom to Galveston, TX. Cristian had an appointment at the Shriner's Hospital there. You see, they are victims of the violence that was still high last year in Juarez.

They were attending funeral services for a relative, when passers-by threw burning cocktails into the funeral home. We understand that some people died in that explosion. Cristian and her mom were two of those who survived; with Cristian receiving 60% burns to her 6 year old little body. She was flown to Galveston, TX where the doctors at Shriner's Hospital saved her life. SAEM said "yes" to the use of our van and with Daniel as their driver, they were able to make it Monday morning into Galveston in time for Cristian's appointment. {Here they are posing for a picture before the hospital visit.} We Praise God for allowing us to help the family and this precious little girl – who will be undergoing surgeries until the age of 20.

**Acts of Love.** Our big "Thank You" goes out to Brownsville Christian Church of Brownsville, OR for their big check towards our Food Ministry for Juarez. A total of 2,000 pounds of food were distributed by Missionary, Daniel to churches, orphanages, old folk's homes, teen challenge, mentally retarded ministry, and street ministry. In addition, SAEM passed out 200 pounds of rice and beans from our mission building to the walk-ins from Juarez who come to see us. They are given these two food items, plus loaves of bread... along with our literature that speaks about the Bread of Life. Amen!
