“I gave out that bread. Wish you could just see the faces of the ministry leaders I gave it to! But, just know that it was a HUGE blessing.” “... On the way home I gave the remainder to a Rehab Center that takes children with drug problems off the streets and also women. Right now the Pastor has 5 kids and 5 women living there. I know that they certainly will benefit from this bread, Thanks so much.”... “I took about 5 boxes of bread to an orphanage at kilometer 30, 3 boxes to a church with a feeding program at kilometer 33, 5 boxes to a Christian private school with over 100 kids (they struggle for food), and 1 box to a feeding ministry.” ... “I got rid of all the bread - people were so, so happy to get it, the sweaters and the blankets. Don Chuy was really happy with his clothes.”... “The Pastor wanted to go with me to distribute the stuff. Even though he lives in Juarez, he didn't realize people were so bad off.” ... “The kids tore into the bread like they never seen food before. The bread was still very cold; kids didn't care.” ... “I spoke to the Pastor about going back and having a special service just for these two families.”... “They way I see it, I should never leave the mission without a load of clothes and bread, if you have it.”

You see, we are given supplies and they do not last long around here, the Lord makes it possible to keep them moving. In the case of day old bread, which Angelica, a volunteer, picks up once a week; it does not last. We use a freezer and a refrigerator for a couple of days while the bread is taken to Juarez; some by fellow missionaries from El Paso. Another missionary uses our Bibles and tracts, and now BREAD in his Juarez ministry. He is the one who relates this true tale: He went to a humble home with Scriptures and bread. When the lady found out that the food

was for her, she began to cry with emotion because she had been praying to God for help. Out of money, and out of food, now her prayers were answered. Her children opened the plastic wrap and began to eat it with nothing on it. To me, there is nothing quite like putting food in the mouth of a hungry child, they are absolutely innocent of the causes of poverty. I see it, don't you? Jesus set the example, "Give us this day our daily bread."
