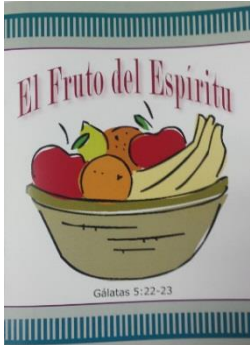


ANOTHER YEAR COMING TO A CLOSE
